### **Role Summary:**

The main purpose of this role is to contribute to the evidencing of impact activities and delivery of impact outcomes that contribute to Cardiff Met's aspirations for REF2029.

The post holder will report to the University Impact Development Manager and work closely with Research & Innovation Services (R&IS), Schools, PDR and internal and external stakeholders.

### **Principal Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Contribute to the gathering and auditing of impact data.
- Liaise with key individuals based in the Schools/Units and RIS to support the effective collation of evidence of impact activity.
- Use in depth knowledge of research and data collection techniques to support successful impact activity outcomes.
- Conduct literature and data-based searches, and where appropriate, undertake report writing to support the production of research outputs and impact activity outcomes.
- Promote knowledge sharing via presentation of findings.
