Core purpose of role

You will create helpful, informative, and engaging video content to inspire students to study at the University.

Key responsibilities and contributions

- Create and contribute to social media content, to show prospective students what it is like to live in Cardiff.
- Create and contribute to social media content, to show prospective students what it is like to study at Cardiff Metropolitan University and the opportunities available.
- Pitch and take on content ideas as directed by various teams within the Marketing, Communications and Student Recruitment department.
- Contribute to the filming and editing of social media short form video content, both in front of and behind the camera.
- Collaborate with other Student Content Creators, as well as staff and students across the University, to create a variety of well informed and engaging content.
- Become a brand ambassador and share your Cardiff Metropolitan University story through authentic content in a positive and engaging way.
- Attend meetings and training to discuss content plans and ideas and develop your content creation skills.
- Attend a variety of events on campus and externally to create content and showcase student life.
- Maintain a thorough knowledge of student life both at the University and in the city of Cardiff.

- Stay up-to-date with social media channels and trends to help inform content planning.
